## Wauchope High School Breakfast Club

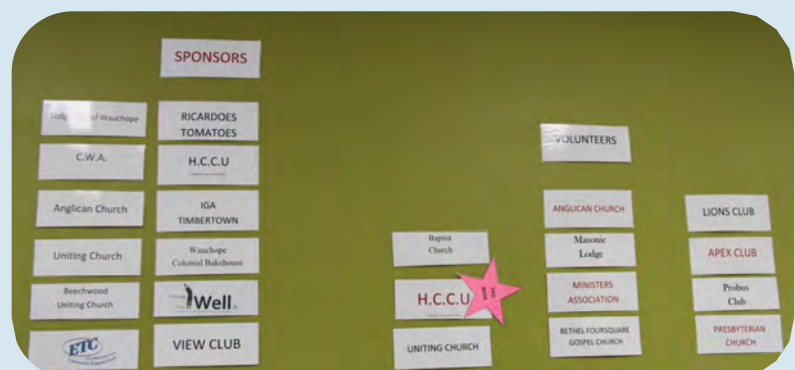
Since 2014 the Wauchope community has run a Breakfast Club at Wauchope High School.
