


### JUNIOR GIRLS' FOOTBALL




Well done girls on a great effort. Next year should be more kind to us.



The P&C AGM has been rescheduled to Tuesday 18 May 2021 at 6pm at Wauchope RSL Club, in the Rosewood Room upstairs.


